Dear parents and students,

## Greetings from Indian School Salalah!!

As per the examination timetable circulated on Sunday, October 3, 2021 the Term 1 Pre-Board Examination will commence from 17 October 2021 for class XII and from 18 October for class X.

Students are hereby requested to follow the below mentioned guidelines strictly:

- The COVID-19 vaccination certificate (one or two doses) is mandatory to enter the school premises as per the ministry guidelines. They need to carry a copy of the vaccination certificate to the school.
- Students should have taken at least one dose of the approved vaccination before coming to the school.
- It is mandatory to fill the **Daily Health Status Form** before coming to the school by **6:30** am and entry will not be allowed if the form is not filled. We request the parents to fill the form between 6:15 am to 6:30 am so that the staff on duty can identify students with health issue.
- It is mandatory to wear a mask while coming to the school. Kindly carry extra pair of masks.
- Parents are requested to drop and pick their respective wards near the KG
  Block Entrance.
- Parents are requested not to send the students to school if they show any signs of illness.

- Students are advised to carry their own water bottle, sanitizers, tissue papers and other necessary materials.
- Students are advised not to get together in groups. They should maintain social distancing at all times (inside as well as outside the school campus.)
- Students need to come to school in proper school uniform.
- If students feel unwell, they should report immediately to the invigilator in the class.
- Entry to the school is only through the main gate. (Gate No. 1, near Indian Social Club)
- Students' reporting time is 7.30 am and dispersal time is 10.00 am.
- Students are advised to carry only writing materials and must avoid carrying study materials on Examination days.
- The class teachers will conduct exclusive sessions on the upcoming examination in which they will communicate the room allotments and other arrangements for the onsite examination.
- Parents are expected to cooperate with the staff on duty and to follow the instructions
- Students are expected to follow all the safety guidelines issued by MOH,
  MOE and ROP.
