General guidelines for students & parents

- The participants should come only in school uniform for practice.
- Participants should carry required snacks and water during practice days.

• All the students should wear their ID card without fail while coming to school.

• On carnival night the students are permitted to come in civil dress, however we expect our

students to come in smart and modest dress wear. ID card is mandatory.

Participants should ensure to report to the teacher in-charge of the event for the practice as

well as on the carnival night on time.

• The participant pass will be given to all the participants and only those with pass can enter the

school building.

The parents who are helping the event in-charges will also be provided with the green room

entry pass to enter into the school building.

• The cleanliness of the campus is the responsibility of every student of the school, hence

students should not litter the carnival ground and should make use of the dustbins kept.

The students are expected to maintain the decorum of the school.

Any act of indiscipline by the students will result in sending the student out from the carnival

ground.

Usage of mobile phone should be reasonable and taking pictures and videos without the

consent of others should be avoided.

• Sharing the photos and videos without seeking permission from the people in the

photos/videos is an offense hence students should avoid themselves from doing that.

Parents are not requested to enter inside the school building on the carnival day. They can

approach the help counter to communicate.

entrance.
