Greetings from Indian School Salalah!

We are extremely delighted to welcome our dear children back to school and we look forward for a happy and rewarding association with you and your little ones. On the basis of the guidelines from MOE and MOH, class IV will be having their onsite classes from Sunday, 14th November 2021.

Kindly adhere to the following guidelines to provide a safe environment for all the children

- 1. The school timing for class IV students is from 7:30 am to 11:25 am
- 2. The reporting time is 7:15 am at the rear side entrance of main building.
- **3.** The dispersal time is from 11:30am, however we expect the **parents to reach by 11:25 am**The dispersal is through the rear entrance of main building.
- 4. Kindly ensure to reach school on time to pickup your ward on time.
- 5. Please ensure that your child is brought to school and taken back by a responsible person.
- 6. It's mandatory for you to fill the health status declaration Google form of your ward everyday morning before coming to school preferably before 6:30 am Google Form link: https://forms.gle/1PU6ZtyBXnHN7gM49
 Vindly engure to fill the Coogle form shored to mention the vegginetion status of all the coogle form.

Kindly ensure to fill the Google form shared to mention the vaccination status of all the family members at home who are 12 years and above.

- 7. Wearing mask is optional.
- 8. Kindly provide them some tissue papers and personal hand sanitizers (optional), however our classrooms will be equipped with tissue papers and hand sanitizers.
- 9. Children should be given a reasonable amount of nutritious dry snacks. A cloth napkin should be sent with the snack box. Junk food like chips should not be sent frequently.
- 10. The subject note books which your ward is using right now should be sent with them.
- 11. Children should not be sent with gold chains, bangles, long earrings or wrist watches. Girls however can wear a small ear stud if essential.
- 12. Your ward should stay at home when sick and should be sent to school only when he /she has recovered fully. The class teacher should be informed duly regarding the absence and if the child remains absent for more than three days, a letter should be sent to the class teacher addressed to the principal.

- 13. If the kids are suffering from any illness and any allergies to the medicine then it should be informed to the class teacher with the medical reports.
- 14. Batch1 children will come to school on Sunday and Tuesday
- 15. Batch 2 children will come to school on Monday and Wednesday.
- 16. Thursday is online for all the students.
