(Message from Mr. C M Najeeb, Director In-Charge of Indian School Salalah & Vice Chairman,
Board of Directors of Indian Schools in Oman)

Dear Parent,

I am addressing this message to you with the hope that you would take some extra interest-extra steps-extra time for your child's best performance in the Board examinations in March 2017.

Time has come yet again for your 'extra interest-extra efforts' for your own children's best performances in the Pen and Paper, Practical Examinations.

01. Do prepare your child for the SPECIAL COACHING at home, EVERY DAY. Let him/her sit freely and happily to work on books/notes, a minimum of FOUR HOURS daily after returning from School. During school study leave and holidays, let this time be increased to TEN HOURS every day till the examinations are over. It's just a two months extra efforts for you to encourage and support.
02. Do take extra care if your child is relatively a WEAK student and send him/her to extra classes EACH DAY. **January and February months are important. Not to be wasted.**
03. Do complete all portions' study at home, well in advance, so that you can ask the School for REVIEW CLASSES, if required. Please discuss with the subject teacher at your respective School, openly and responsibly.
04. Do prepare the mindset of students for home studies in disciplined manner – send them to GURUKULAM classes at the School, which are being conducted to prepare them for the final exams.
05. When ever needed, please do COUNSEL the student privately and separately, taking time to encourage, motivate and excel in exams, if he/she is not cooperating at home for studies.
06. When ever needed, please do COUNSEL yourself privately and separately taking time to arrange conducive circumstances at home, to avoid parties, to avoid late nights, to monitor girls and boys at home always – also to avoid excessive and un-wanted use of internet – Please love and encourage your wards. Please do NOT overburden the child with excessive pressure and unrealistic goals.
07. There is a need of a partnership between the PARENTS-TEACHERS and STUDENTS to bring the BEST out of each student and I ask you to work with FOCUS-GOALS-DEADLINE at the earliest – Do Not Pressurize the student, give him/her full support to score high marks.

08. Good communicative English must be always used by the parents-students-teachers admin staff at all times within the school campus as a thumb rule - encourage this at home and make all at home aware of this – Lead by Example.
09. Please give a bright and silent place at home for your ward to sit and learn /study the subjects and languages with proper breaks in between, after coming from School.
10. Allow each student, a reasonably good time of ONE HOUR for recreation, music or physical games in the evening hours. Early morning studies to be promoted at home.
11. You should AIM for FULL A+ RESULTS and high distinctions for your son/daughter and encourage them with promises of value gifts if they achieve the goals.
12. If for one reason or other, they fail to score the high marks as desired, do take it light and encourage for better results in the next examination, making him/her more responsible to manage study time.
13. Whether your child passes with high scores or distinction or passes with lesser marks, in all cases your child is a winner and warrior in life, depend and believe in him/her for the abilities.
14. I wish your child all the very best in the examinations and would want to see that he/she becomes one of the FULL A1 RESULT holder or high scoring student with commendable distinction.

Finally, I should like to thank you for sending your ward to *Indian School System* for secondary and senior secondary studies and assure you of our fullest attention at all times for overall growth of the student with values and principles in life. I seek your partnership and supporting hand in accomplishing this goal. Do volunteer to support your school with open heart. I like to see the Middle East Topper/s once again comes from Oman Schools.

I would appreciate if you keep me informed of the steps that you would PLAN-IMPLEMENT with time line after consultations with the stakeholders - do take this seriously and prepare your own action plans one better than anyone else after proper consultations within the family. *May the Good Lord Help and Bless You Always - Season's Greetings and Happy New Year*
