

Indian School Salalah excels in Class 12 CBSE results

The results for class 12 CBSE board exams were declared today around 9am by CBSE, New Delhi and there was a feel of excitement and happiness among everyone at Indian School Salalah about the excellent results that are being achieved year after year.

The school has been very consistent in securing brilliant results and this year too they have done extremely well. The concerted effort put in by the management, principal, staff and students helped the students to come out with flying colours with top scores and distinctions.

In the Science stream, Master Imtiazuddin Gazi, Miss Kanika Dilip Ashar and Miss Anushka Srivastava topped the school with 476 marks (95.2%) followed by Miss Fathima Yusra Imran Zaheer with 473 marks (94.6%) and Master Dhiraj Kumar J P Kyumar with 472 marks (94.4%). In the Science Stream out of 71 students who appeared for the class 12 exam, 63 got distinction i.e. above 75%, and 8 students secured marks between 60% and 74%.



In the Commerce Stream, Miss Nahan Naser topped with 453 marks (90.6%) followed by Miss Jerusha Sheba Maben 449 marks (89.8%) and Miss Nimra Kanwal Ahmed with 445 marks (89%). In the Commerce stream, out of 62 students, 16 students got distinction and 40 students secured marks between 60 and 74.
