IX had to be satisfied with sixth position in long jump, whereas Mohd. Fadi Shabeer of class IX clinched the bronze medal in badminton.

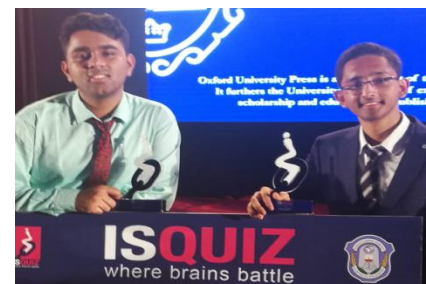
INDIAN SCHOOL SALALAH STUDENTS EXCEL IN HIGH SCHOOL SCIENCE FAIR COMPETITION

This mock drill is carried out every year to refine the evacuation plan and to ensure that everyone in the school is prepared for an emergency. To familiarize the newly appointed staff with the evacuation steps to be taken during a fire, a session on fire mock drill, followed by its presentation was organized by Mr. Mohandas, Faculty Physical Education and Mr. Mahesh, Health and Safety Officer in the auditorium. A well planned fire mock drill was executed at 10:45 am on Thursday, 25th April 2019. The teachers guided the students along the nearest evacuation route to the assembly point. The emergency squad ensured that no student or staff was trapped in the building and thus, the time required for the complete evacuation of the school was recorded as 4 minutes 17 seconds. The Annual Fire Safety Drill, thus, certifies the safety of all the students and staff of Indian School Salalah through the well planned evacuation procedure.
