Dear Parents,

Greetings from Indian School Salalah!

This is to bring to your kind notice that, as per a directive issued by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health, there has been a recent increase in cases of infectious diseases—most notably measles and chickenpox—among students. In view of this, urgent preventive measures have been mandated to safeguard the health and wellbeing of all students. **Therefore, we seek your full cooperation in implementing the following measures with immediate effect:**

1. Health & Attendance

- If your child is unwell, kindly ensure that they remain at home, take adequate rest, and recover fully before returning to school.

2. Special Advisory – Measles & Chickenpox

- In case your child is diagnosed with **measles or chickenpox**, they must remain at home until complete recovery.
- Re-joining school will be permitted **only upon submission of a medical fitness certificate**, clearly stating that the child is no longer infectious.

3. Early Reporting & Cooperation

- Parents are requested to inform the concerned Class Teacher immediately if their child is diagnosed with any infectious disease.
- This will enable timely implementation of necessary preventive measures.

4. Immunization & Medical Records

- Parents/guardians must ensure that their child's immunizations are complete as per the Immunization Schedule.
- Submission of the child's **immunization card** is mandatory during admission.
- In case of incomplete immunization, proof of initiation of the vaccination schedule must be provided.

5. Vaccination Data Collection & Consent

- The school is in the process of collecting updated vaccination details of all students.
- **All parents are requested to submit a copy of their ward's vaccination/immunization schedule to the Class Teacher at the earliest, and no later than 30th April 2026.**

These guidelines are essential to prevent the spread of infections and to ensure a safe and healthy learning environment for all.

We request your understanding and cooperation in adhering to these directives in the best interest of the entire school community.
